Forest care for greener tomorrow

BINTULU: PTTEP Sarawak Oil Limited is continuing its tree planting initiative, "Nourish Nature, Nurture Future," this year, aiming to plant 500 trees in two sessions.

The oil and gas exploration service company said that this programme addressed environmental challenges

such as rising emissions and increasing soil erosion.
