Leading judge among those conferred award carrying 'Datuk Seri' title

HIS Majesty Sultan Ibrahim, King of Malaysia, yesterday conferred federal awards, decorations and medals on 54 recipients in conjunction with the Federal Territory Day celebration at Istana Negara.

Present at the investiture was Her Majesty Raja Zarith Sofiah, Queen of Malaysia.

Leading the honours list was Court of Appeal President Datuk Abu Bakar Jais, who was conferred the Seri Mahkota Wilayah (SMW) award, which carries the title "Datuk Seri".
