

Varsities ready to swear in candidates

KUALA LUMPUR: As the dust settles on the recent campus elections, some universities were preparing to swear in their winning candidates as part of the 2012-2013 student representative council.

At Universiti Putra Malaysia (UPM), the successful student council representatives would be officiated on Monday.

UPM Deputy Vice-Chancellor Prof Datuk Dr Mohd Fauzi Ramlan said even though the unofficial results had been announced following campus polls on Tuesday, the university had allowed one day for students to protest against the results.

Following any protest, the university will reveal its decision on the issues today and students will be given the right to appeal the management's decision on Friday and Sunday.

At Universiti Utara Malaysia, student council representatives will be formally elected on Oct 4 concurrent with the council's internal election for council positions.
