PHAMA AWARDS

THE Pharmaceutical Association of Malaysia's inaugural PhAMA Awards 2014 went to a joint project titled The Decision Making In Insulin Therapy, by Universiti Malaya, Universiti Putra Malaysia and the Ministry of Health, under the Minister of Health Innovation and Research Award.

The winners received RM12,000. "We accept this award on behalf of all our colleagues who have helped us achieve this feat," said Prof Dr Ng Chirk Jenn.

Meanwhile, the PhAMA President's Community Impact and Awareness Award went to University of Nottingham Malaysia Campus for its Water4Life project.
