KUALA LUMPUR: Universiti Tenaga Nasional (Uniten) has been awarded a RM6 million research grant under the smart partnership research and

development programme by the Higher Education Ministry. The achievement is a milestone for Uniten as it's the only private higher learning institution selected for the

learning institution selected for the programme. "Uniten is the only university owned by a government-linked com-pany to receive research grants from the ministry," said Uniten director of public affairs Datin Noor Zarina Musa yesterday.
