

Sanjay aims to score for UM

WITH the cancellation of the World Men's Team championship in Egypt due to security reasons, Sanjay Singh's attention is on the ongoing Grand Finals of the 1Malaysia IPT squash tournament at Universiti Malaya Squash Complex in Kuala Lumpur.

The tournament may not be as prestigious as the world meet but the 21-year-old intends to give his best shot and lift the title in his final competition for the year before he takes a break.

Sanjay, top seed in the men's division one, has every reason to do well as he will be playing in front of his university mates.

The National No 3 clinched the 1st leg of the 1Malaysia IPT circuit in October in Penang but missed out on the two legs in Malacca and Bukit Jalil last month due to the clash in dates with the Malaysia Squash Tour.

Sanjay's main rivals are Mohd Amir Farhan Ampandi from Universiti Putra Malaysia or Shaun Kuan from Nilai University.

Shaun emerged as champion in the second leg in Malacca while Farhan bagged the third leg at Bukit Jalil.

In the women's Division One, Nazihah Hanis Abdul Razak from International Islamic School Malaysia is seeded first ahead of Siti Nurul Jannah Mohd Razak of Universiti Sultan Zainal Abidin.

A total of 128 participants from 25 universities across the country are vying for honours in the men's Division 1, 2, 3A and 3B and women's Division 1 and 2.
