Perlis Tan Sri Syed Anwar Jamalullail heads a list of people to be conferred awards in conjunction with the 70th birthday of Sultan of Selangor Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah.

He will receive the state's highest honour, Darjah Kerabat Selangor Yang Amat Dihormati, at an investiture at Istana Alam Shah, Klang, tomorrow.

They are Selangor Royal Court member Tengku Datuk Paduka Putra Alhaj Tengku Azman Shah Alhaj, Appeals Court judge Datuk Mohd Zawawi Salleh and Selangor State Secretary Datuk Mohammed Khusrin Munawi.

Paduka Mahkota Selangor, which carries the title Datuk.

Dr Zainul Rashid Mohamad Razi, state Health director Dr S. Balachandran, Sepang Municipal Council chairman Puasa Md Taib and state Town and Country Planning Department director Mohd Zaki Ibrahim.

Six people will receive the Setia Mahkota Selangor, eight will receive the Setia Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah, 15 will be awarded the Ahli Mahkota Selangor, 16 will receive Ahli Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah award and seven will be awarded Bintang Perkhidmatan Cemerlang medal, all of which do not carry titles.
