The lecture series, which began in November 2007, grew from a pre-existing series organised by a loose grouping of local theorists and colleagues as well as those from abroad.

With EQuaLS, the series has become a successful regular event at INSPEM.

Registration fees, inclusive of lecture materials, lunch and tea breaks, are RM500 each for local students and RM800 for local non-students, and US\$200 for international students and US\$250 for international non-students.
