KUDOS to our divers Pandelega Rinong and Cheong Jun Hoong for their magnificent silver medal win. The first medal for Malaysia in the women's 10m platform synchro brought cheers and smiling faces to fellow Malaysians at home and abroad.

Both star divers heeded their coach Yang Zhuliang's advice to remain calm and focus on their remaining dives, and ended up scoring a total of 344.34 points

after five dives at the Maria Lenk Aquatics Centre.

This is Pandelega's second medal at the Olympics, the last one being an individual bronze at the 2012 London Olympics in the 10m platform synchro.
