



UPM leads in the innovation of disposable safety syringe, non-penetrative vacuum blood container

Universiti Putra Malaysia (UPM) has succeeded in producing a novel multi-purpose disposable Safety Syringe and a non-penetrative Vacuum Blood Container, or SJ-VacTube, the first to have been made in this country. Both technologies which are related to each other, are used in the process of transferring and storage of liquid such as blood for laboratory use, medical, veterinary and the like. Both innovations are produced by a team of researchers, led by Assoc. Prof. Ir. Dr. Abd Rahim Abu Talib from the Department of Aerospace Engineering of the university's Engineering Faculty.
