Farmers, rural folk to benefit, says Ismail Sabri

KUALA LUMPUR: Farmers and people in rural areas will get some good news from the 2018 Budget that will be tabled on Oct 27.

Rural and Regional Development Minister Datuk Seri Ismail Sabri Yaakob said he had proposed a few things to Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak.

"We have asked for many things. Hopefully, the prime minister will approve them," he said after the University College of Agroscience Malaysia's 16th Convocation at Universiti Putra Malaysia in Serdang yesterday.
