

7 receive SIRIM Quality Award 2017



AS an annual signature event of SIRIM and continuing on the success of SIRIM Quality Award 2016, SIRIM Quality Award 2017 was once again held for all SIRIM clients.

With the objective of giving formal recognition to SIRIM's clients who had achieved high level of excellence in quality management systems in various sectors, SIRIM Quality Award had at the same time raise awareness and trigger a wave of quality consciousness among organisations and industries.

The award was aimed at bringing value to the loyal customers as well as function as a platform for winning organisations to participate in national quality awards.

This year, the award concentrated on SIRIM Quality Award for organisations.
