Nineteen of them will receive awards that come with titles.

For the awards that do not come with titles, 13 individuals will receive the Setia Mahkota Selangor (S.M.S) and another 13 people will receive the Setia – Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah (S.I.S).

Among those receiving the S.I.S is the Sultan's niece Tengku Munazirah Tengku Abdul Samad Shah, who is the founder of social enterprise Hope Factory Malaysia.

Twenty individuals will receive the Ahli Mahkota Selangor (A.M.S) award while 19 and seven others will receive the Ahli – Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah (A.I.S) and the Bintang Perkhidmatan Cemerlang (B.P.C) awards respectively.
