

Selangor MB gets 'Datuk Seri' title

KLANG: Menteri Besar Amirudin Shari headed a list of 91 awards, honours and medals recipients in an investiture in Selangor, held in conjunction with the 74th birthday of Sultan of Selangor Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah at Istana Shah Alam here yesterday.

Amirudin was awarded the Darjah Kebesaran Seri Paduka Mahkota Selangor, which carries the title "Datuk Seri".

Universiti Putra Malaysia Vice-Chancellor Professor Datin Paduka Dr Aini Ideris received the Darjah Kebesaran Datuk Setia-Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah, which carries the title "Datin Paduka Setia".

Leading the list of nine recipients of the Darjah Kebesaran Datuk Paduka Mahkota Selangor (D.P.M.S.), which carries the title "Datuk" for men and "Datin Paduka" for women, is Selangor Syariah Chief Judge Mohamad Adib Husain.

Other DPMS recipients were Malaysian Ambassador to Sweden Nur Ashikin Mohd Taib, Royal Malaysian Navy deputy chief Vice-Admiral Datuk Abdul Rahman Ayob, Army Headquarters Assistant Chief of Staff Major General Datuk Badrul Hisham Muhammad, Selangor Water Authority director Datuk Ir Hashim Osman, YTL Power International Bhd managing director Datuk Yeoh Seok Hong, Selangor Deputy State Secretary (Management) Zamani Ahmad Mansor, Universiti Putra Malaysia Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Research and Innovation) Professor Dr Zulkifli Idrus, and UPM bursar Zulkiflee Othman.
