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The pollination biology of four common species of Malaysian fruit trees, namely the mango (Mangifera indica), the cashew (Anacardium occidentale), the carambola (Averrhoa carambola) and the rambutan (Nephelium lappaceum) was studied. The mango is andromonoecious and was found to be self-compatible. Intervarietal cross-pollination using the Malgoa
