Dominant factors affecting self-efficacy of emergency department nurse in implementing resuscitation

ABSTRACT

The purpose of this research is to analyze the most dominant factors that influence the selfefficacy of emergency room nurses in carrying out resuscitation in cardiac arrest patients at RSUD Dr. R. Koesma Tuban via observational analysis with a cross-sectional study approach. As a result, the resulting coefficient of significance was mastery experience (p = 0.043) and verbal persuasion (p = 0.039) which is smaller than 0.05, showing a meaningful relationship. In conclusion, mastery experience was the dominant factor influencing the self-efficacy of emergency room nurses in carrying out resuscitation in cardiac arrest patients in the emergency room.
