## Resignations will not derail universities: Jayum

KUCHING: The resignation

of two United Malay National Organisation (Umno) division chiefs from the board of public universities will not affect their management, said Universiti Putra Malaysia (UPM) political science Prof Dr Jayum Jawan.

"The chairs and members of university governing boards should be given

to qualified people who can contribute to the

advancement of knowledge and the university.

"Other than that, should the universities appoint new board members or chairman, it must be someone who is able to contribute to the university" said layure.

He was commenting on the resignation of Umno supreme council member Datuk
